

A WORD OF THANKS // The parishioners and guests who joined us for celebrations of Holy Week and Easter this year are certainly aware of the amount of dedicated work that goes in to arranging our liturgies. Parish staff and volunteers have been preparing for months, and their talents shine as brightly as their desire to serve. Choir members, altar servers, decorators and liturgical ministers together form a team of volunteers that keep our parish the beautiful place we've all come to know and love. To all those who made gifts of self or of any kind this season: Thank you!

EASTER SEASON // The seven weeks from Easter to Pentecost (June 5) are celebrated as one great feast day. St. Athanasius called them "the great Sunday." Christians sing the "Alleluia" during these days in their rejoicing.

SPECIAL MEANING OF EASTER // The communal character of the Eucharist emerges in a special way when it is seen as the Easter banquet in which Christ himself becomes our nourishment. In fact, "For this purpose Christ entrusted to the Church this sacrifice: so that the faithful might share in it, both spiritually, in faith and charity, and sacramentally, in the banquet of holy communion. Sharing in the Lord's Supper is always communion with Christ, who offers himself for us in sacrifice to the Father." Dies Domini, #44

FLAME OF FAITH // The Paschal or Easter Candle is the most important symbol of the Resurrection. It's lighted at the Solemn Easter Vigil and then stands next to the ambo throughout the entire fifty days of the Easter Season. The newly baptized are welcomed into the Church by its light and it speaks of eternal life at every Funeral Mass.

BAPTISMAL WATERS // The celebration of Easter and the Sacrament of Baptism are intimately connected. Easter is the beginning of life in Christ. On Easter Sunday, we renewed our baptismal faith and were sprinkled with water blessed at the Easter Vigil. On Divine Mercy Sunday, we close the Easter Octave by celebrating the Rite for the Blessing and Sprinkling of Water at the beginning of all parish Masses.

VIGIL MASS TIME CHANGE // As of this weekend our Saturday Vigil Mass has shifted to a 4PM start Confessions are now from 3PM until 3:45PM.

HOLY WATER AT THE DOOR // At the doors of every Catholic Church you will find a Holy Water Font. We dip our fingers into the water and make the Sign of the Cross whenever we enter or leave the church. This simple gesture reminds us that Baptism is the gateway to life in Christ and membership in the Church.

EASTER DÉCOR // Thank you to all those who helped beautify our sanctuary for the celebrations of Easter. A list of those being remembered through our Easter Décor has been included in this bulletin.

CONGRATULATIONS BISHOP MIEHM // This past week our Bishop celebrated his 5th anniversary as Shepherd of the Diocese of Peterborough.

ORDINATION OF PETER LUKOW // Deacon Peter Lukow will be ordained a priest on Friday, May 27th at 7PM at St. Peter's Cathedral - let's remember Deacon (soon to be Father) Peter in our prayers!

CHURCH BOILER UPDATE // With the Diocese's approval, work has begun to prepare the church for the installation of the new boiler system. **The cost** of this project is \$45,383.52. If we want our church to be heated, we need to make this payment. This is a huge financial hit to our operations, and we are therefore going to need to raise these funds. We will publish a fundraising tracker next week, as donations are starting to come in! Boiler pledge envelopes are available in the Church (these donations (over \$25) will receive a tax receipt).

RECTORY & OFFICE UPDATE // Much-needed renovations have been taking place at the Rectory and Parish Office. Thankfully, the majority of the materials and labour has been very generously donated. Work continues to be on-going and Father is very grateful for the kind donation of time and expertise as this work gets completed.
