On Saturday November 26th at 1PM, we're hosting our 2nd annual Advent Wreath Making event in our Parish Hall. All materials and tools are provided. The cost for the materials is \$30 per family, or if you attended last year and have your Advent ring, the cost is \$7.00 per family.
