



Ash Wednesday

Among the beautiful, meaningful, and solemn ceremonies of the Catholic Church is the gathering of the faithful on Ash Wednesday.

This special day begins our Lenten journey on February 22nd. It is the start of 40 days of prayer, penance, and almsgiving as we prepare ourselves to celebrate the resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ on Easter Sunday, April 9th.

The Church will be open all day on Ash Wednesday for private prayer and devotions.

- We gather outside and burn the palms that were distributed last year to make ashes for Ash Wednesday.
- 6PM: Pancake Supper

CANDLEMAS, PRESENTATION OF THE LORD

On **Thursday, February 2nd**, come celebrate Candlemas! This special occasion commemorates the day that the baby Jesus was presented at the Temple in Jerusalem. At this Mass we'll be blessing the candles that will be used throughout the liturgical year (and you will be welcome to take one home).

FEAST OF ST. BLAISE - FEBRUARY 3RD

Christians endure illness and physical suffering in this life as all people do. However, our faith reminds us that suffering will not have the last say. Not only that, but Jesus' own suffering becomes an invitation for those who are sick or suffering to turn to him as the true remedy of all torments.

So, we ask for the intercession of the saints to help us turn to Our Divine Physician and entrust all those suffering and sick into his care.

One way Catholics have traditionally done this is through the blessing of throats on the feast of St. Blaise, bishop and martyr which will be available at Mass.
