# The Season of Lent

This coming Wednesday is Ash Wednesday and so we begin the season of Lent. The season of Lent is a time of repentance, change of heart and prayer. We journey with our Lord to his ultimate betrayal and his passion on the Cross.

The three pillars of Lent are Prayer, Fasting, and Almsgiving. It is through the observance of these three Lenten practices that we hope to enter into Lent as one person and to step out into Easter as a better, more Christ-like version of ourselves.

# ASH WEDNESDAY IS A UNIVERSAL DAY OF FASTING AND ABSTINENCE

#### About Fasting:

Fasting among Christians is a penitential discipline intended to open our hearts to God and others, a meaning of purification and spiritual liberation, a witness of the depth of our Faith. The law of fasting binds those from 18 to 59 years of age.

#### **About Abstinence:**

The simple act of abstaining from meat joins us to the sacrificial heart of Jesus. The law of abstinence from meat binds those who are 14 and older.

#### **ABOUT THE ASHES**

The Ashes that are used to mark the beginning of Lent come from the branches blessed and distributed on Palm Sunday last year. We will be burning the Palms on February 21st at 5PM in the parking lot. *Everyone welcome to join in!* 

#### LAST CALL FOR PALMS

It's that time of year - Ash Wednesday is coming up fast! Please place your palms in the box marked "Returned Palms" in the Narthex so we can burn them on Tuesday.

#### **LENTEN PASTORAL VISITS**

If you know of anyone, or are yourself, unable to leave your home to attend Mass, please call the parish office and leave your name. During Lent, Fr. Jerry would like to visit our shut-ins to offer anointing of the sick, Holy Communion or just a short visit with a cup of tea in the comfort of their home.
