HOLY THURSDAY - APRIL 6

Holy Thursday commemorates the institution of two sacraments: Holy Orders and Eucharist. The Mass of the Lord's Supper takes us back to the upper room where Jesus washed the feet of the disciples, ordained them as priests and commissioned them to celebrate the Eucharist for others: "do This in memory of Me.' 6PM Parish Supper

8PM Mass of the Lord's Supper 9PM Adoration at the altar of repose (until midnight).

GOOD FRIDAY - APRIL 7

We celebrate the day when Jesus paid the ultimate price for our salvation by dying on the Cross. Mass is not celebrated on this day, but liturgies of Good Friday bring us to the veneration of the Cross on which Jesus died.
