

Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with thee.



May is the month traditionally dedicated to Mary, Mother of God. We honour her for her primary role in God's work of salvation. Consider praying the rosary as a family during this month or add a few extra Hail Marys to your regular prayers.

PARISH ROSARY CHALLENGE: Pray one rosary a day, for the month of May! This challenge is open to individuals and families too. Keep track, and when you visit the Church, you can indicate the number of rosaries prayed using our 'rosary tracker' near the Statue of Mary in the Sanctuary.

Last year we prayed 521 rosaries!

ADDITIONAL OPPORTUNITIES TO PRAY THE ROSARY:

1 During the month of May, parishioners who wish are invited to remain after the weekend Masses to pray the Rosary.

All year round, parishioners are welcome to join in the public recitation of the Rosary after Mass on Wednesday evenings.



GOOD SHEPHERD SUNDAY

The 4th Sunday of Easter highlights the Good Shepherd who gives his life for his sheep. This is a day where we pray for our Priests and for vocations to the priesthood. Who will shepherd God's people? Pray that good leaders, filled with joy and the Holy Spirit, will serve the Lord and His Church.

MOTHER'S DAY RAFFLE

HOLY WATER AT THE DOOR

At the doors of every Catholic Church you will find a Holy Water Font. We dip our fingers into the water and make the Sign of the Cross whenever we enter or leave the church. This simple gesture reminds us that Baptism is the gateway to life in Christ and membership in the Church.

REMEMBER THE BOW

We are asked to show our respect for the Eucharist by making a simple bow of the head before receiving Jesus in Holy Communion. All glory and honour to Him!

HOSPITAL VISITATION

The Sacrament of Anointing the Sick is the healing touch of Jesus. We encourage parishioners to ask for this blessing before entering the hospital for surgery or other medical procedures. In case of emergency, a Catholic priest is always on call. Place a request at the Nursing Station and they will contact a priest for you.
