

St. André Bessette (Brother André) is the first Canadian living after Confederation to be canonized and a great many miracles of healing have been attributed to him. The saint was known especially for his devotion to St. Joseph and to caring for the sick.

Normally, his relics reside at St. Joseph Oratory in Montreal, but on Wednesday, November 15th, his relics will be brought to our Parish.

Month of the Holy Souls

The Month of November is all about remembering. As Catholics we call to mind our deceased family and friends, asking God's mercy upon them. We also pray for the many forgotten souls who depend on us for prayerful support. Envelopes are available at your exits or the Welcome Desk if you would like to make a donation in memory of your loved ones. We will remember these beloved dead at every Mass celebrated in the month of November.

CATHOLIC FUNERALS

For Catholic men and women, death is a reality faced in the company of Jesus Christ, the Resurrection and the Life. It's not so much a celebration of someone's life, as a celebration of God's saving love. Catholic Funerals have three distinctive steps: 1) A Vigil of Prayer at the Funeral Home; 2) A Funeral Mass at the parish church; 3) Burial Rites at the cemetery or mausoleum. In answer to a much asked question: yes, Catholics may be cremated, but cremated remains should be buried with dignity in a consecrated space.

The new St. Joseph Sunday Missals are now on sale at the Welcome Desk after all weekend Masses or during the week at the Parish Office for \$5 each. These Sunday Missals are a great source for parishioners who would like to follow along with the Sunday readings, and they make a great stock stuffers too!

FAMILY ADVENT WREATH MAKING PARTY

Advent is a season of four Sundays that mark the beginning of the Church year and helps us prepare for the celebration of Christmas. Christians often observe the progress of this season with an Advent wreath, a wreath with four or five candles that are progressively lit throughout the season. On Saturday, December 2nd at 10AM, we're hosting our 3rd annual Family Advent Wreath Making Party in the Parish Hall. All materials and tools are provided. The cost for the materials is \$30 per family, or if you attended last year and have your Advent wreath ring, the cost is \$8 per family. We ask you to pre-registration at the Welcome Desk after all weekend Masses or by contacting the Parish Office. Space is limited, so register guickly.

REMEMBRANCE DAY

Saturday, November 11th, is Remembrance Day. We hold in our hearts those who have died in the ugly violence or war and pray for peace in the world. As Catholic Christians we rededicate ourselves to the work of God's Kingdom. Together, we renew our commitment to love our enemies in the name of Jesus Christ. Mass will be celebrated at our regular Saturday time of 4PM.
