Among the beautiful, meaningful, and solemn ceremonies of the Catholic Church is the gathering of the faithful on Ash Wednesday.

This special day begins our Lenten journey on February 14th. It is the start of 40 days of prayer, penance, and almsgiving as we prepare ourselves to celebrate the resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ on Easter Sunday, March 31st.

### CANDLEMAS, PRESENTATION OF THE LORD

On Friday, February 2nd, come celebrate Candlemas! This special occasion commemorates the day that the baby Jesus was presented at the Temple in Jerusalem. At this Mass we'll be blessing the candles that will be used throughout the liturgical year (and you will be welcome to take one home).

### FEAST OF ST. BLAISE - FEBRUARY 3RD

Christians endure illness and physical suffering in this life as all people do. However, our faith reminds us that suffering will not have the last say. Not only that, but Jesus' own suffering becomes an invitation for those who are sick or suffering to turn to him as the true remedy of all torments.

So, we ask for the intercession of the saints to help us turn to Our Divine Physician and entrust all those suffering and sick into his care.

One way Catholics have traditionally done this is through the blessing of throats on the feast of St. Blaise, bishop and martyr which will be available after all Masses next weekend.

### FATHER IS AVAILABLE

It's important to remind parishioners periodically of how we can help in times of serious illness or in the event of a loved one's passing. If a loved one is at the West Parry Sound Health Centre, Father can be summoned for you by hospital staff. Long-term care and retirement homes in the parish all know how to contact our parish office to request a visit, but families are encouraged to reach out to us directly by phone. If someone requires the Sacrament of the Holy Anointing of the Sick and is in danger of death please call the parish office.

### PALMS PLEASE

It's that time of year - Ash Wednesday will be upon us soon (February 14th). We are collecting palms to be burned for use on Ash Wednesday. Please place your palms in the box marked "Returned Palms" in the Narthex.
