Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity

The Solemnity we celebrate this weekend occurs after the conclusion of the Easter Season, the weekend following Pentecost Sunday. It makes sense to do so, as we have reflected thus far during the liturgical year upon the Father's gift of His Son at Christmas, the ministry and teaching of Jesus that culminated with his crucifixion and resurrection from the dead, and finally, the gift of the Holy Spirit given by the Father and the Son after Jesus ascended into heaven. This Sunday is not only a reflection upon the mystery of the Most Holy Trinity, but an invitation into a relationship with our Trinitarian God.

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit: As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.

ADORATION


