



We are asked to show our respect for the Eucharist by making a simple bow of the head before receiving Jesus in Communion.

NEXT STEPS ➤ SHARING OUR FAITH

We wrap up our series by talking about the importance of sharing our faith through evangelization. We have an incredible message to share with the world: Jesus did not come to serve, but to give his life as a ransom for many. Jesus did not come to get something from us, but to give us eternal life that we can access on a daily basis.

OCTOBER IS ROSARY MONTH

We read in sacred scripture that the Blessed Virgin Mary continually pondered the mysteries of Jesus in her heart. Through the Rosary we unite our hearts to hers, and prayerfully ponder those same mysteries.

The Joyful, Sorrowful, Glorious and Luminous Mysteries are a summary of the Gospel. They invite us to contemplate with Mary, our Mother the life, death and glorious resurrection of her Son, Jesus. You can join in the communal recitation of the Rosary on Wednesdays following our 6PM Mass.
