Dear Parish Family,

The countdown is on! We're just days away from celebrating Christ's Birthday! It will probably be a hectic time for some of us because of all that needs to be done, but because of so many people working together here at Church, this will be a Christmas to remember. Everything here at St. Peter the Apostle becomes possible because of all the volunteer ministers who help prepare our church for the Christmas season like those who help clean and decorate, hosts, greeters, behind-the-scenes, and so many more. Many ministers are needed to help make our Christmas Masses amazing. Think about giving some time to warmly welcome all who will come to celebrate Christmas with us this year. This is one of the high seasons in the Church year, and it is our best opportunity of the whole year when it comes to growing disciples-investing and inviting, welcoming new people to our community and introducing them in a new and exciting way to Jesus. Even inviting them to visit us for Mass on Christmas Eve or Christmas Day. Investing in the people that come to us at Christmas is so important. We want to create a wonderful Christmas experience for those who come to us. Here are some of the things that we seriously need to consider putting on our **TO DO LIST** at St. Peter the Apostle as we open our doors to visitors:

1. Pray for our visitors. Beginning today and all through the entire Christmas season which ends on January 8th, the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord, keep them in your prayers.
