JUBILEE 2025: PILGRIMS OF HOPE What is a Jubilee Year?

A Jubilee Year is a significant period of celebration and forgiveness observed every 25 years in the Catholic Church. This sacred time provides a unique opportunity for spiritual renewal, where individuals and communities can reflect on their faith, seek forgiveness, and restore relationships. The essence of the Jubilee is rooted in the themes of mercy and hope, inviting everyone to partake in the grace of God and the joy of reconciliation. Pope Francis has called for a year of jubilee with the theme "Pilgrims of Hope." The 2025 Jubilee officially began on December 24, 2024, with a Mass presided over by Pope Francis in St. Peter's Square, Vatican City, with the rite of the Opening of the Holy Door. For the faithful around the world, the local Diocesan Masses were held on December 29, 2024, including the celebration at the Cathedral with Bishop Miehm.

During the Jubilee Year, Bishop Miehm has designated four churches in our Diocese, one in each deanery, which can be visited to obtain the plenary indulgence:

- Cathedral of St. Peter-In-Chains, Peterborough
- St. Michael the Archangel, Cobourg
- St. Patrick's, Kearney
- · Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Lindsay.
