



#### **FATHER IS AVAILABLE**

It's important to remind parishioners periodically of how we can help in times of serious illness or in the event of a loved one's passing. If a loved one is at the West Parry Sound Health Centre, Father can be summoned for you by hospital staff. Long-term care and retirement homes in the parish all know how to contact our parish office to request a visit, but families are encouraged to reach out to us directly by phone. If someone requires the Sacrament of the Holy Anointing of the Sick and is in danger of death please call the parish office.

#### **CHARITABLE TAX RECEIPTS**

To accommodate the recent postal strike, the federal government has extended the deadline for donations in 2024. Those who wish may request a separate receipt for offerings made in January and February of 2025 which can be submitted with a tax return for either the 2024 or 2025 tax year (not both); the 2025 receipt for those choosing this option would only include offerings made in March through December. Otherwise, all donations made in 2025 will be applied to the 2025 tax season.

If you would like to receive tax receipts for January and February 2025 to claim in 2024, please contact the parish office via email at office@spta.church.

Unless specifically requested, your charitable tax receipt will only reflect donations made during 2024.

The Ashes that are used to mark the beginning of Lent come from the branches blessed and distributed on Palm Sunday. We will be burning the Palms on March 4 at 5PM in the parking lot. Everyone is welcome to join in!
