Ash Wednesday is coming! Lent begins on March 5th. The season of Lent is a time of repentance, change of heart and prayer. We journey with our Lord to his ultimate betrayal and his passion on the Cross.

ASH WEDNESDAY IS A UNIVERSAL DAY OF FASTING AND ABSTINENCE

About Fasting: Fasting among Christians is a penitential discipline intended to open our hearts to God and others, a meaning of purification and spiritual liberation, a witness of the depth of our Faith. The law of fasting binds those from 18 to 59 years of age. About Abstinence: The simple act of abstaining from meat joins us to the sacrificial heart of Jesus. The law of abstinence from meat binds those who are 14 and older.

No matter who you are, or where you are on life's journey, you are welcome here!

As we journey through this holy season of Lent, we invite you to join us for Soup & Stations—a time of simple fellowship and prayer.

Each Friday of Lent, come share a warm bowl of soup and good company at 5:15PM in the Knights of Columbus Hall. Then, at 6PM, we will gather in the Church to pray the Stations of the Cross, reflecting on Christ's love and sacrifice for us.

Lent is a time to grow closer to Jesus and to one another. Whether you come alone, with family, or bring a friend, we would love to journey with you. Let's set aside this time to nourish both body and soul as we prepare our hearts for Easter.

24 HOURS FOR THE LORD
