

This coming Wednesday is Ash Wednesday and so we begin the season of Lent. The season of Lent is a time of repentance, change of heart and prayer. We journey with our Lord to His ultimate betrayal and His passion on the Cross.

The three pillars of Lent are Prayer, Fasting, and Almsgiving. It is through the observance of these three Lenten practices that we hope to enter into Lent as one person and to step out into Easter as a better, more Christ-like version of ourselves. #### **ASH WEDNESDAY IS A UNIVERSAL DAY** OF FASTING AND ABSTINENCE

#### **About Fasting:**

Fasting among Christians is a penitential discipline intended to open our hearts to God and others, a meaning of purification and spiritual liberation, a witness of the depth of our Faith. The law of fasting binds those from 18 to 59 years of age.

#### **About Abstinence:**

The simple act of abstaining from meat joins us to the sacrificial heart of Jesus. The law of abstinence from meat binds those who are 14 and older.

#### SHROVE TUESDAY, MARCH 4TH

#### - BURNING OF THE PALMS 5:30PM

Bring your old palms from last year's Palm Sunday as we prepare the ashes for Ash Wednesday. It's a beautiful way to begin Lent, surrendering the past and making way for renewal.

#### - PANCAKE SUPPER

After the palms become ashes, come enjoy a delicious pancake supper with our parish family! This long-standing tradition is a wonderful way to gather in fellowship before Ash Wednesday.

#### **SOUP & STATIONS**

During the Holy Season of Lent our Parish will be serving soup prior to Stations of the Cross. Soup will be served at 5:15PM in the KofC Hall for the Fridays of Lent. Immediately after our warm meal, we will gather in the Church to pray and reflect upon the Stations of the Cross for 6PM. We want to journey alongside you during Lent. Please bring your family and friends and join us!

#### 24 HOURS FOR THE LORD

As part of the Jubilee of Hope, we invite you to 24 Hours for the Lord, a time of grace and prayer through 24 consecutive hours of Eucharistic Adoration on March 7-8th. Encounter Jesus, seek His mercy, and pray for our parish and the world. Adoration begins Friday, March 7th, at 12Noon and concludes Saturday, March 8th, at 12Noon. Sign up for an hour or come as you are able.

#### **FRIDAYS WITHOUT MEAT**

Meatless Fridays are a timeless tradition in the Catholic Church. The simple act of abstaining from meat joins us to the sacrificial heart of Jesus. We encourage every parishioner to adopt this penitential practice on the Fridays during Lent.

#### **JUST FOR LENT - FEARLESS**

Does fear have a stronghold in your life? Would you like to turn it over to the Lord? Would vou like to allow Him to give you life to the full?

#### **CONFESSIONS**

Experience the healing power of unconditional forgiveness. Father is available to hear confessions on Saturdays between 3:00PM-3:45PM in the Confessional. If it's been a while or you don't know how to start - don't worry....Father will help you through it. Don't let the sins of the past weigh you down.

If you know of anyone, or are yourself, unable to leave your home to attend Mass, please call the parish office and leave your name. During Lent, Fr. Jerry would like to visit our shut-ins to offer anointing of the sick, Holy Communion or just a short visit with a cup of tea in the comfort of their home.
