

The Ascension of Our Lord, which occurred 40 days after Jesus Christ rose from the dead on Easter, is the final act of our redemption that Christ began on Good Friday. On this day, the risen Christ, in the sight of His apostles, ascended bodily into Heaven.

Jesus' last earthly gesture toward the disciples was to bless them. In response, the disciples "did him homage" and experienced "great joy." This response was not to Jesus' departure from them, but was an expression of a new relationship to him, the risen One. Now instead of accompanying him in his ministry, they were "clothed with power from on high" to be his presence and do his ministry. In essence, Jesus' last gesture toward the disciples was to empower them to be "witnesses of these things."

PREPARE FOR PENTECOST!

Pentecost, the celebration of the outpouring of the Holy Spirit is next weekend. Pray this every day leading up to next weekend: "Lord I pray that all who have been away from the celebration of Mass for any reason may return home, and that our church will be a welcoming community of faith.
