STATEMENT BY THE MOST REVEREND DANIEL MIEHM, BISHOP OF PETERBOROUGH, UPON THE ELECTION OF POPE LEO XIV

We have received the great and joyful news of the election of a new pontiff: Cardinal Robert Prevost, formerly the head of the Dicastery for Bishops, who has chosen the name Pope Leo XIV.
