50 DAYS OF JOY

The seven weeks from Easter to Pentecost are celebrated as one great Feast Day. St. Athanasius called them "the great Sunday". During these 50 days of rejoicing Christians sing the "Alleluia" with gusto and enthusiasm. White or gold vestments are worn by priests and deacons and the sanctuary is sumptuously decorated.

FLAME OF FAITH

The Paschal or Easter Candle is the most important symbol of the Resurrection. It's lighted at the Solemn Easter Vigil and then stands next to the ambo throughout the entire fifty days of the Easter Season. The newly baptized are welcomed into the Church by its light and it speaks of eternal life at every Funeral Mass.

HOLY WATER AT THE DOOR

At the doors of every Catholic Church you will find a Holy Water Font. We dip our fingers into the water and make the Sign of the Cross whenever we enter or leave the church. This simple gesture reminds us that Baptism is the gateway to life in Christ and membership in the Church.

PRAYER PARTNER WEEKEND

This weekend we invite our parish family to pray for the children preparing to receive their First Holy Communion in June. As they get ready to welcome Jesus in the Eucharist for the very first time, may they grow in faith, wonder, and love for the Lord. Let us surround them with our prayers and encouragement during this special time in their journey with Christ.

MAY IS FOR MARY

The month of May is traditionally dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary. We honour her as the Mother of our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ, and as the first of his Disciples. We also acknowledge Mary as the Mother of the Church and our mother too!

PARISH ROSARY CHALLENGE: Pray one rosary a day, for the month of May!

This challenge is open to individuals and families too. Keep track, and when you visit the Church, you can indicate the number of rosaries prayed using our 'rosary tracker' near the Statue of Mary in the Sanctuary. Last year we prayed 1,513 rosaries!!
