

Christians often observe the progress of this season with an Advent wreath, a wreath with four or five candles that are progressively lit throughout the season. On Saturday, November 29th at 10AM, we're hosting our annual Family Advent Wreath Making Party in the Church Basement. All materials and tools are provided. The cost for the materials is \$30 per family, or if you attended last year and have your Advent wreath ring, the cost is \$10 per family. We ask you to pre-registration at the Welcome Desk after all weekend Masses or by contacting the Parish Office. Space is limited, so register quickly.

In the final weeks of the liturgical year, the Church turns her attention to imagery in Scripture that may find dramatic, if not outright frightening. The overwhelming message of Divine Revelation is that God desires to persist in real and personal relationships with us. We are precious to him. The circumstances of the world (even ones as dramatic as the End Times) do not change this.
